CESSATION OF MANDATORY PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

This advisory brings attention to the cessation of the Mandatory Precautionary Measures for all ships arriving at EDB managed shipyards and process terminals for contact operations and/or contactless operations, with immediate effect.

2 Ships calling at EDB managed shipyards and process terminals and shore-based personnel boarding these arriving ships for work must adhere to the Marine Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) Port Marine Circular (PMC) No. 05 of 2022 or subsequent succeeding PMC.

3 Mandatory Precautionary Measures for contact operations could be reinstated, should the need arises e.g. detection of new Variant of concern or surge situation. Therefore, EDB managed shipyards and process terminals are encouraged to incorporate the Mandatory Precautionary Measures into their Business Continuity Plan.

4 Contactless or Segregated Contactless operations remain the default mode of operation where functionally possible.

5 As the COVID-19 pandemic is not over, all companies are to remain vigilant and continue to review their business operations to be COVID resilient. This is to ensure business continuity and to protect your workers from infection.
